### **Treasurer's Report** – Natalie Moore and Stephanie Kellenberger

- Funds available are \$22,087.57.
- Highlights:
  - Paid \$13,173.60 for coaches' salaries, \$435 for garage signs, \$400 for two-a-days meals
  - Sold 17 stadium seats at Jamboree
  - Earned \$890 from Cornhole Classic; still waiting on a check from Porch Growler, which is anticipated around \$400
  - Charity Mania money has not yet been deposited; we have \$8,000 in online sales plus paper ticket sales
  - Earned about \$3,600 from ad sales in fall sports program

- Glenn is the new secretary for Cards Inc.
- August meeting topics were: teams saving money; desire for little carryover money from year-to-year; tax info. turned in 8/15; Cards Inc. does not need to know when we have restaurant/dining nights
- It was chaotic at Jamboree with cross country meet taking place at the same time, parking was a challenge and booster groups need strong signage at the event.
